## Door/gate

## <u>Shepherd</u>

You are indeed our shepherd so we trust in you to lead us through the green pastures of life and through its dark valleys, bringing us safely home at the last. Amen.

## **Resurrection**

Lord Jesus, we give you thanks that now there are no dead ends in life, and even death itself is an open door. Put new life in us and raise us up to new heights of living in this world and in the next. Amen.
